



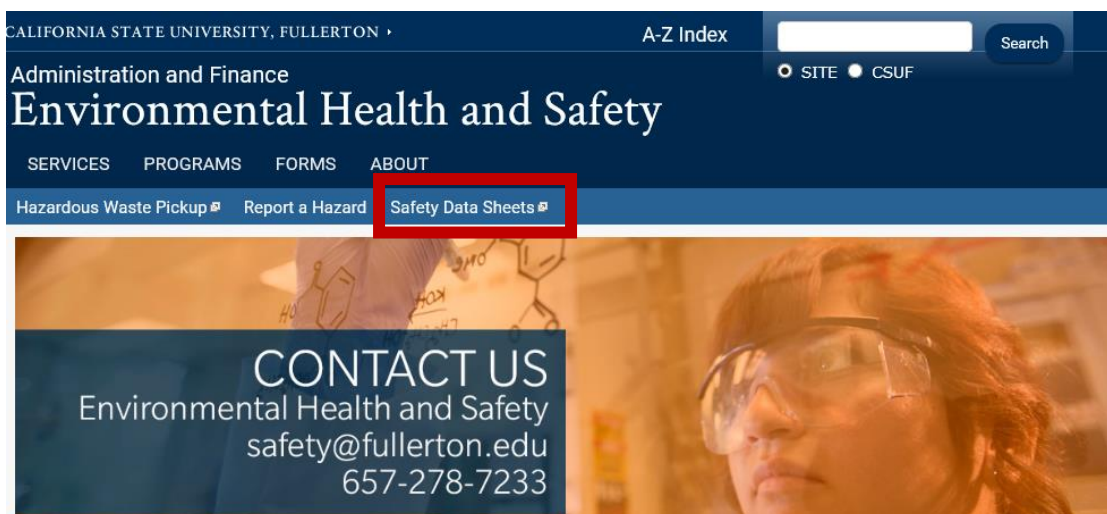
Safety Data Sheets (SDSs)

Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) are detailed fact sheets summarizing information about a chemical, including health and physical hazards, emergency procedures, chemical reactivity and incompatibility, and disposal procedures. SDSs are available online to members of the campus community.
